TRASH AND RECYCLING

JULY RECYCLING DAYS: MONDAY: July 1 + July 15

- DO NOT put plastic garbage bags, food waste, or household garbage in blue bins.
- **BULKY TRASH** is picked up every Monday. **To avoid fines**, place curbside the night before collection, at least 5 feet from collection bins: utility poles, cars, or any other structure.
- **NOT ALLOWED:** Construction debris, auto parts, paint cans or items more than 150 pounds.
- **ACCEPTABLE YARD TRASH:** Tree cuttings up to 5 feet long, bagged leaves, piles no higher than 5 feet.
- Call 311 to request **replacement bins**.

BE PREPARED: HURRICANE ESSENTIALS

- Fresh batteries for flashlights and radios
- Update your first-aid kit
- Non-perishable snacks and packaged food
- Waterproof jacket/poncho
- Have 1 gallon water per/day/person for 3-7 days
- Prescription medications
- Pet food and bedding
- Extra propane tanks or gasoline for generators
